Perch/Crappie (each)	15	30
Bluegill/Sunfish (any combination)	15	30
Bullhead	No limit	No limit
Catfish	10	20
Nongame fish	No limit	No limit

The following waters have size and/or limit restrictions as indicated.

Campbell Slough, Day County

Walleye: Minimum length 15"

Smallmouth/Largemouth Bass: *Must be less than 14" or 18" or longer, but may only keep one that is 18" or longer.*

Enemy Swim Lake, Day County

Walleye: Minimum length 15"

Smallmouth/Largemouth Bass: *Must be less than 14" or 18" or longer, but may only keep one that is 18" or longer.*

Pickrel Lake, Day County

Walleye: Minimum length 15"

Smallmouth/Largemouth Bass: *Must be less than 14" or 18" or longer, but may only keep one that is 18" or longer.*

Lake Traverse (Minnesota-South Dakota Border Water)

High grading of any species not allowed.

Walleye/Sauger/Saugeye: (any combination) 4 daily and possession; only one may be over 20"; closed March 1 – April 22.

Northern Pike: 6 daily and possession; closed March 1 – April 22

Largemouth/Smallmouth Bass: (any combination) 6 daily and possession; closed March 1 – April 22

Perch: 15 daily and 30 possession

White Bass: No limit

Rock Bass: 20 daily and possession limit

Bluegill/Sunfish: (Green, Pumpkinseed, Orangespotted, any combination) 10 daily and possession

Crappie: 10 daily and possession

Bullhead: 100 daily and possession

Catfish: (any combination) 5 daily, and only one maybe over 24"

Nongame Fish: No Limit

Whitestone Lake, Roberts County

Highgrading of any species not allowed.
