In the matter of the appeal of Block versus White, the Sisseton-Wahpeton Supreme Court has received briefing and a Motion to Dismiss Notice of Appeal. The Court has reviewed the material and finds the following:

- 1) Sisseton-Wahpeton Oyate Rules of Civil Procedure 39 (c) states that an appellant, to be timely, must file with the trial court a notice of appeal within twenty days of order of judgment;
- 2) The trial court entered judgment against Block, denying her the ability to advocate in the courts of the Oyate, on December 29, 2015;
- 3) Block made Notice of Appeal on March 24, 2016, past the twenty day timeline.
