Request for Proposals:

The intent of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is for the purpose of selecting a qualified contractor to provide personnel, equipment, and supplies necessary for well drilling services. The requested services will be for two drilled water wells and pump systems for livestock watering purposes. The two wells will be drilled in two different locations. One location is in McKinley Township, Marshall County and the other is located in Alto Township, Roberts County. The design drawings and construction specifications can be obtained from the SWO Fish & Wildlife Department.

All bids received after this closing time will not be opened. All bids received on time will be opened in the Administrative Office at 10:00 AM April 29, 2024 by the Procurement Officer with the Program representative and Executive Office in attendance.
